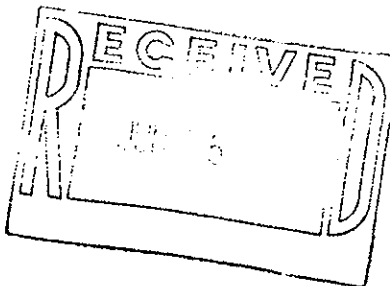

Dear Jeanie:

As discussed on the phone, I have been using Elastogel on my patients with moist desquamation reactions due to radiation therapy. This has been very successful in keeping the wounds clean and eliminating any trauma which may occur. It has provided relief to the burning sensation after the patient placed the Elastogel in the refrigerator. I have had several patients use it, and they have only required one dressing during their entire course of treatment which lasts approximately 2-3 weeks for complete healing to occur.
